



RESIDENCE OF DR. V. C. PATTEN,
OF MORRISTOWN, BURNED
TUESDAY AFTERNOON

The home of Dr. V. C. Patten, of Morristown was destroyed by fire Tuesday afternoon, which started about 1:30 o'clock. The origin of the fire is not known. The flames were first noticed in the upstairs apartment. The loss is estimated at about \$6,000, which is partially covered by insurance.

The work of neighbors and friends saved most of the contents. Many household articles of furniture were carried to safety it was reported. The fire truck from Morristown was called and assisted largely in fighting the flames, but the fire had gained considerable headway before its arrival, it was stated.

Dr. Patten has only recently married and was engaged in placing new furniture in the home.
