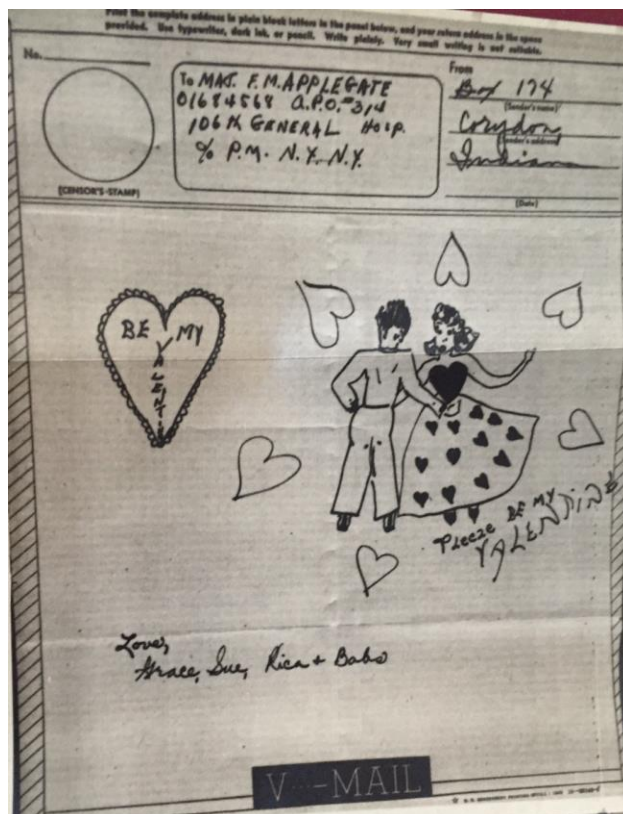
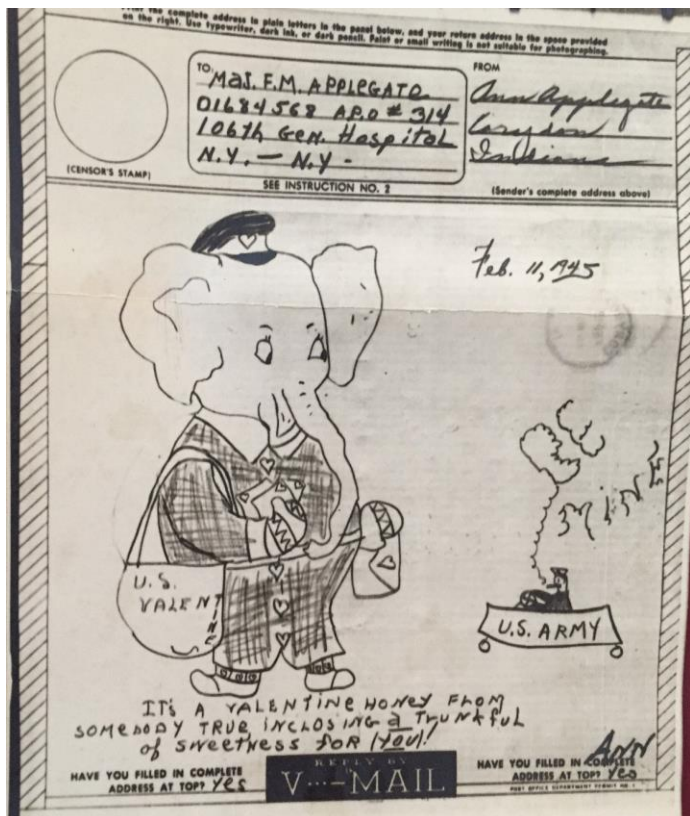


These are cartoons drawn by Ann when she was 12. She sent them to her daddy, Ted, when he was stationed in England. They were dated Feb. 11, 1945.
