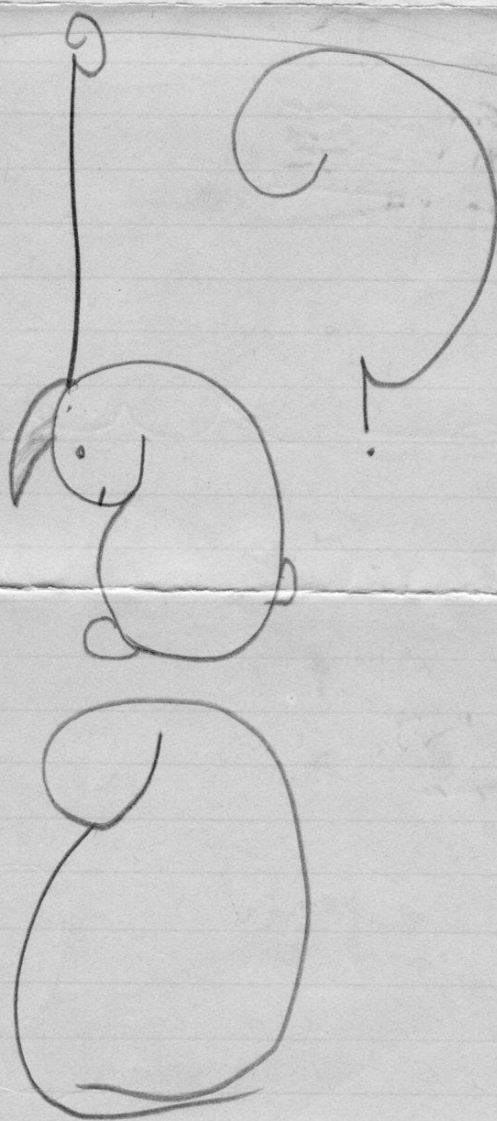

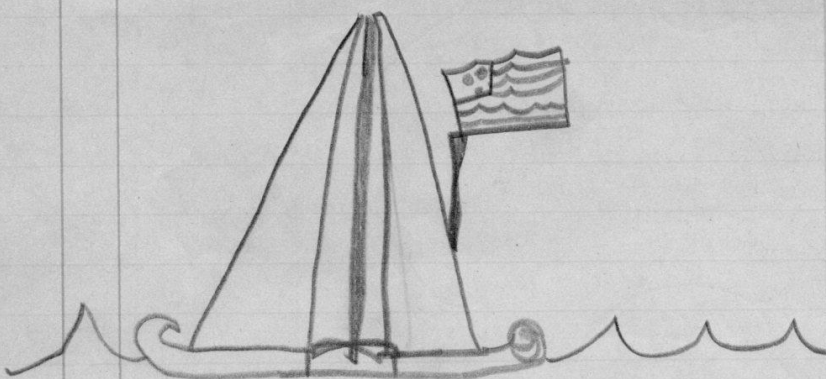

I made Rica a right sweet purse. I made pajamas for the dolls that "Latita Claus" is going to bring them - ha ha ha! Mother bought some yellow and blue pants over in Warem, Mexico and the rubber in mine were so thick that they had to go to Grace and Sue. Also, the rubber in mother's was so thick that she had to keep the largest pair for herself and give the one that was so thick with rubber to me. We have a black persian - stray cat and Irist, my dog, now. The persian had kittens before we took her in, one black and the other light yellow. We feed them twice a day. Nice to hear of the doll family you are planning.

Bobbie about that ~~hat~~ - hat - I had
